(including a stepparent) should be reported on the FAFSA. Exclude a parent who has died or is not living in the household because of separation or divorce. Include a parent who is on active duty in the U.S Armed forces. they live with the student's parent(s) (or live apart because of college enrollment). If your parent(s)' will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. if they now live with your parent(s) and your parent(s)' provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other people" align with the requirement that family size align with whom the parent can claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing any the 2024-2025 FAFSA. As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.
